### Update in relation to IFM

On 8 June 2022, Atlas Arteria (**ASX:ALX**) announced that it had been advised by the IFM Global Infrastructure Fund (**IFM**) that IFM had obtained a combined relevant and economic interest in approximately 15% of the issued securities of Atlas Arteria. IFM also stated the intention to request access to certain limited company information, before deciding whether to submit a non-binding indicative proposal to acquire all the Atlas Arteria securities it does not already own.

Atlas Arteria has subsequently received a request from IFM for access to certain information, including non-public and confidential information about the company and its assets for the purpose of developing a formal proposal. Atlas Arteria has not received any proposal from IFM to acquire additional securities in Atlas Arteria.

The Boards of Atlas Arteria have considered the request and have decided not to provide non-public information at this time. However, the company has offered to provide IFM with the opportunity to meet with senior management to discuss selected topics on the basis of publicly available information. This is consistent with the company's past practice in its dealings with large institutional securityholders.
