Nuclear Power Plants Authority awards Worley a contract for the first Egyptian nuclear power plant

The Nuclear Power Plants Authority (NPPA) of the Arab Republic of Egypt has awarded Worley a consultation services contract for the first Egyptian nuclear power plant.

Worley will provide consultation services to NPPA to support the implementation of the nuclear power plant project at El Dabaa, which is on the Mediterranean coast, west of Alexandria. The power plant will comprise four pressurized water reactors with a nameplate capacity of 4800 MW.

The services to be provided by Worley include the technical support to NPPA in engineering and design review, project management, procurement, construction management, training, procedure development, quality assurance, commissioning and related activities. Worley has worked with NPPA since 2009 and this contract extends the relationship until the end of 2030.
